

**Regular Meeting of
Monday April 2, 2012**

Mayor Christopher Jackson called the regular meeting of the Walhalla City Council to order, 7:00 P.M., Monday April 2, 2012 at City Hall.

Moved by Ermer to approve minutes of March 5, 2012 as presented, second by Karel. Ayes: All, Nays: None.

Moved by Solberg to approve the Financial Report as presented, second by Ermer. Ayes: All, Nays: None. Motion carried.

Communications: Letter from the ND Department of Health congratulating Brian Mathison and staff for their work and achievements regarding the Safe Drinking Water Act. The Department of Health has issued a "Certificate of Compliance" on a job well done.

City also received an invitation to the Mar-Kit Sanitary Landfill annual meeting, and a written notice that ADM elects to terminate participation concerning the water treatment plant lease with the City.

Brian spoke to the Council on the need for chip jobs on certain areas in town, and the Council should think about getting the old reservoir demolished.

Moved by Solberg to approve building permits for Soeby Ford, Dean Benoit with condition that the utilities sign and more measurements on fence, Farmers Elevator/Wilbur Ellis with condition that they follow plumbing specs and have all utilities sign permit, second by Jackson. Ayes: All, Nays: None. Motion carried.

Kathy gave an update on the process with the clinic building. Contractor will be bidding out the work.

Moved by Solberg to pay all bills presented, second by Karel. Ayes: Karel, Horgan, Solberg, Jackson, Ermer and Volk-Schill. Nays: None. Motion Carried.

Mayor informed the City Council that there is nothing to report regarding the Tax Assessors Position, Council would like to put an ad in the papers on the position for a couple weeks.

Dan has finished typing up the Ordinance Book. He will email all Council Members a copy to look through and suggest any changes before next meeting when the revised Ordinance will be approved.

Alderman Karel suggested to hold off on buying a loader for at least a year to see where the City is at on equipment. Moved by Karel to reject all bids on the loader, second by Volk-Schill. Ayes: Karel, Horgan, Ermer and Volk-Schill. Nays: Solberg and Jackson. Motion carried.

Kathy updated the Council regarding the equipment from the former Tarnel Business.
